Attention Commuters—Latest on Widening the 205

The project will widen Interstate 205 from four-lanes to six-lanes from Hansen Road to Interstate 5, widen existing structures, construct a median barrier and re-strip Interstate 5 prior to the northbound I-5 / I-205 connector. It's anticipated that the widening will improve safety and reduce traffic congestion and delays during peak periods. **Completion is scheduled for 2008.** Estimated construction cost is \$92 million. The joint venture contractors are O.C. Jones and Sons Inc of Berkeley and C. C. Myers of Rancho Cordova. The I-205 widening from

11th Street in Tracy east to I-5 has been funded with a combination of state and local revenues and a loan to the State from Measure K, the local transportation sales tax for San Joaquin County.

My 5th Grader Is Going To College

Thanks to San Joaquin Delta College, my son, Alex has a passport for two years paid tuition.

When my husband and I bought our first home and moved to the area with our three children, we weren't thinking "college education." We were just happy that we owned a beautiful new home and our son was an honor roll student in the 5th grade. Now, he has been given a wonderful opportunity through San Joaquin Delta College and a new program they created this year called Passport To College.

Passport to College is a program that targets all 2006/2007 fifth graders in 146 public elementary schools throughout San Joaquin county and is funded by donations to Delta College from local businesses investing millions of dollars in our children's college educations. The goal of Passport to College is to increase the region's college attendance rate by making a college education possible for all high school graduates. Upon completion of the program, your child will be given a certificate redeemable to Delta College for two years paid tuition beginning in the fall of 2014-2015.

As a parent, this program eases a lot of financial and emotional stress because the first two years our son will be in College; he can remain living at home while he makes the huge leap into adulthood. He won't be far from Delta, and adjusting to the high demands of college will be easier on him with his family and friends by his side. Passport to College will enable those involved to go to Delta College for two years graduating with their Associates degree, or allowing them to transfer as a junior and graduate from the four-year University of their choosing.

As many residents already know, San Joaquin Delta College is an accredited public, two-year community college. The main campus is located on 165 acres at 5151 Pacific Avenue in Stockton. They educate, inspire, challenge and support a diverse community of learners enabling them to achieve academic, professional and personal excellence. With Passport to College, Delta College will most definitely live up to its reputation of being our communities' first choice to learn, work and grow.

Though the Passport to College program is ONLY being offered to current fifth graders, and will only be offered for a limited time, it is not too late to sign up. To be eligible, your child must be in the fifth grade and sign up by the last day of their fifth grade class. Parents must give written consent to release the California Schools Information System (CSIS) identification number, any achievement testing scores, and attendance data to San Joaquin Delta College. As students progress to middle and high school they will be tracked and receive presentations from Delta College on skills needed for higher education. That includes field trips to Delta College and presentations given with emphasis on study and test taking skills. In your child's senior year of high school, Delta College will also provide assistance filling out Federal Student Aid applications, as well as Delta College Scholarship applications and there is no charge for any of these services.

I am excited to have this opportunity to get the word out about this free program so that other parents can plan for their child's college education. If your child is a fifth grader this year, you can have the same opportunity that my son Alex has. We all dream of a successful future for our children and this program is a vital part of fulfilling that dream.
